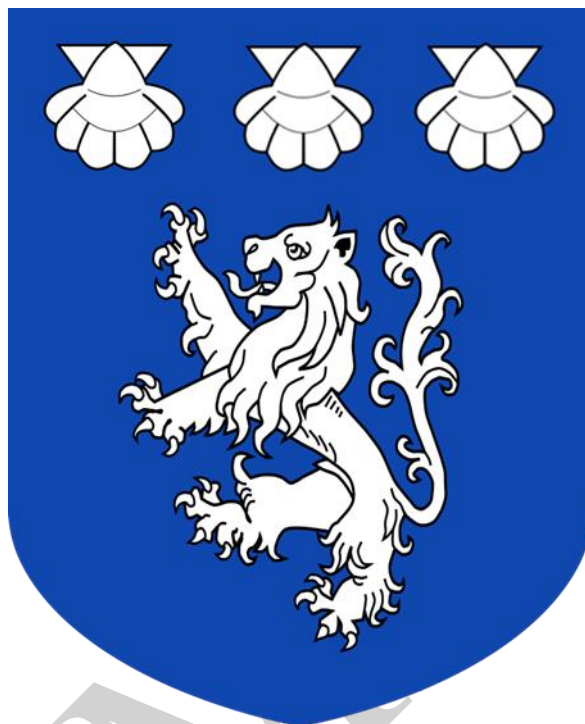

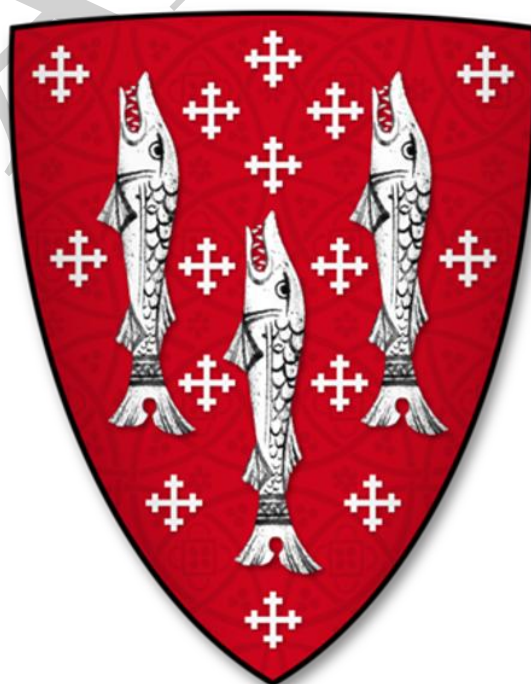

BLAZON these EIGHT shields

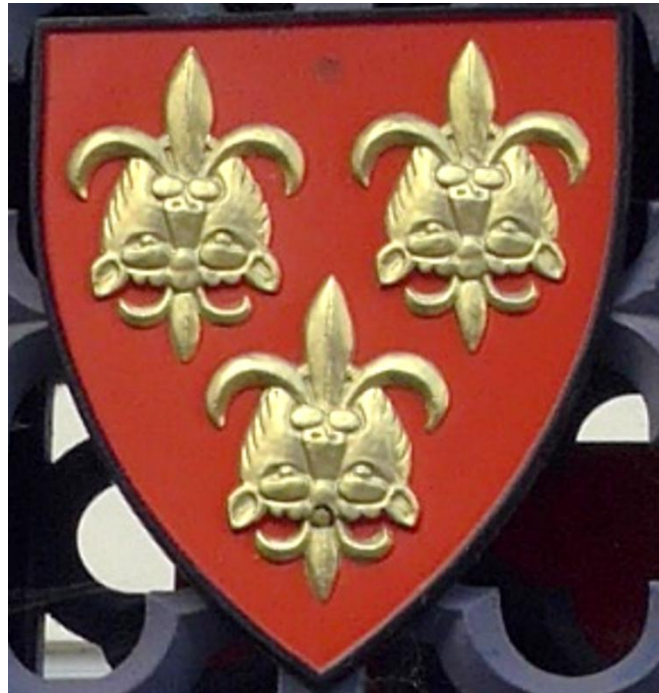

QUESTION 2 (14 MARKS)

DRAW and TRICK the following five blazons:

- 2.1 Gules, on a pale between two feathers erect Argent as many of the same in pale of the field
- 2.2 Or, three Torteaux a label of three points Azure
- 2.3 Or crusilly Azure, a chevron counter-compony Argent and Sable.
- 2.4 Argent, three spearheads in fess Gules, a chief Azure.
- 2.5 Sable, on a Chevron between three griffins' heads erased Or as many estoiles Gules.

DRAW and HATCH the following two blazons:

- 2.6 Per saltire nebuly Ermine and Azure, five annulets in cross Or.
- 2.7 Or two bendlets sinister Vert between in chief a lion's face Azure and in base a fleur-de-lis Gules.

QUESTION 3 (10 MARKS)

DRAW and TRICK the full achievement of:
Peter 6th Baron Carrington of Upton K.G. :

Arms: Or, a chevron cotised between three demi-griffins the two in chief respectant Sable.

Crest: An elephant's head erased Or, eared Gules, charged on the neck with three fleurs-de-lis two and one Azure

Supporters: Two griffins wings elevated Sable, the dexter charged with three fleurs-de-lis palewise Or, the sinister with three trefoils slipped palewise of the last

Motto: TENAX IN FIDE
